

Hamilton County Board of Commissioners RESOLUTION

- TITLE A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE HEALTH SERVICES DIVISION'S BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1989-90 BY ADDING FIVE THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED THREE DOLLARS (\$5,103) TO THE HEALTH SERVICES DIVISION'S BUDGET AND TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE, ON BEHALF OF HAMILTON COUNTY, A CONTRACT WITH THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT FOR AN EARLY PERIODIC SCREENING, DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT (EPSDT) PROGRAM.
 - WHEREAS, additional State income in the amount of \$5,103 has been awarded Hamilton County's EPSDT Program to provide for the transportation of Medicaid recipients to medical care providers; and,
 - WHEREAS, additional expenditures from previously unbudgeted funds has been identified and approved by the Tennessee Department of Health and Environment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY, IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

That the Health Services Division's Budget for Fiscal Year 1989-90 is hereby amended by adding \$5,103 in State funds to the Health Services Division's Budget, thus, amending the total budget from \$88,797 to \$93,900, and the County Executive is authorized to enter into and execute, on behalf of Hamilton County, a contract with the Tennessee Department of Health and Environment for an EPSDT Program in the amount of \$93,900.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS RESOLUTION TAKE EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE, THE PUBLIC WELFARE REQUIRING IT.
